## Call for Abstracts

## Due February 15, 2024

These do not need to be formal papers but rather any project that made a difference in spine surgery quality, safety, or value.

## Details:

- Submission welcome in any area of spine surgery safety, including neuro safety, infection, AVBT, enabling technology, host optimization, systems, culture, etc.
- Submission categories include:
  - Quality
  - · Safety
  - Value
  - · Satisfaction
  - · Other
- Only abstracts submitted in English will be reviewed.
- Abstracts should be original work.
- During the online submission process, you will be required to enter contact information, including e-mail addresses, and disclosures for both the presenting author AND all co-authors.
- Abstracts must not exceed a maximum of 400 words.
- Abstracts should be thoroughly checked for spelling and grammar.
- Do not include the abstract title or author information in the body of the abstract.
- You will receive an e-mail confirmation after the submission.

<u>Presentation Format:</u> The three Best Papers will be invited to present from the podium at the Safety in Spine Surgery Summit, May 31, 2024 in New York City. Additional abstracts may be invited to present digitally via ePresentation or video.

<u>Grants:</u> Current spine fellows who submit noteworthy papers may be eligible for free registration to the Summit.

Award: The Best Paper will receive an award of \$500

Notifications of acceptance will be sent out by March 12, 2024 via email.
